**\*Public Comment Policy** – As adopted by Resolution **2024 -13** Union Township taxpayers and residents shall have an opportunity, to comment on matters of concern, or action, or deliberation which are or may be before the Union Township Board of Supervisors and currently on the Township Agenda. Matters not on the agenda shall be commented upon at the close of the meeting under Public Comment. This period of time is for comments only is not a time to engage in a question and answer or debate with the Board. Comments from the Board are at the option of the Board. The Board retains the option to accept all public comments at this time. The time allocated for the public comment period will be limited to three minutes per person. The Board of Supervisors has the right to extend a speaker's time at their sole discretion. Both residents and non-residents shall provide their names and addresses to the Township Secretary to record in the minutes. Anyone who refuses to provide their name and address may not be recognized to speak. Anyone who conducts themselves in an inappropriate manner (as determined by the Chair) may be asked to leave the meeting. In the event that the Board determines that there is not sufficient time for residents or taxpayers of the Township to comment, the Board may defer the comment period to the next regular meeting.
