UNION TOWNSHIP RECREATION BOARD REGULATED DEER HUNT 2025-2026

The Union Township Recreation Board in cooperation with the Pennsylvania Game Commission will conduct a regulated **archery hunt** between September 20, 2025 and January 24, 2026 inclusive.

Persons interested in receiving a permit to participate in the regulated hunt should be aware of the following:

- 1. Archery Hunt is open to Union Township Residents Only
- 2. Applications will be accepted only from persons possessing a current Pennsylvania Hunting License and a Wildlife Management Unit 5 CM Antlerless License.
- 3. All laws, regulations, and special hunt conditions of the Pennsylvania Game Commission and the Union Township Recreation Board are applicable.
- 4. Participants must display hunt permit in their vehicle and on their person while hunting.
- 5. Twenty-one (21) permits total three (3) per session will be issued for the season.
- 6. Hunters will pick up their permits at the Union Township Municipal Complex. All licenses must be presented at that time.
- 7. All bow and arrow equipment designated for use in Wildlife Management Unit 5C by the Pennsylvania Game Commission is permissible.
- 8. <u>Portable</u> tree stands are permitted in the recreation area. <u>Stands and trail cams must be labeled with permit number</u>. <u>Must be a minimum of 50 yards from any trail</u>. Any stands left after the hunt will be confiscated by the township.
- 9. Vehicles of hunters must be parked in designated parking areas.
